**NOTIFICATION FOR EXERCISING WEB-OPTIONS FOR FINAL PHASE OF
COUNSELING FOR PG DENTAL MDS ADMISSIONS UNDER COMPETENT
AUTHORITY QUOTA INTO DENTAL COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO KNRUHS**

In continuation to this office notification dated: 17-04-2020, 05-05-2020 & 01-06-2020, KNR UHS hereby notifies the conduct of final phase of web based counseling for allotment of vacant seats reverted after second phase of All India Quota Counseling by MCC and the vacant seats after second phase of counseling for Post Graduate MDS courses under Competent Authority Quota in all Dental Colleges of Telangana State affiliated to KNRUHS for the year 2020-21.

The candidates whose names are notified in the provisional final merit list of PG Dental Admissions on the website of KNRUHS Warangal & candidates registered after lowering of NEET PG MDS 2020 cutoff score and in the merit list displayed on KNRUHS website on 15-07-2020 are eligible to exercise web - options online from computer with internet connection.

The Candidates who were allotted seats as per their options in the second phase of counseling and who have not joined / discontinued the course after joining are not eligible for exercising web- options for final phase of counseling. Candidates who have already joined in PG MDS Course after allotment in All India Quota Counseling by MCC are also not eligible to exercise web-options.

All the eligible candidates whose names are displayed in the Provisional final merit list including PWD Candidates on KNR UHS website can exercise web options for admission into PG MDS seats in the Dental Colleges affiliated to KNRUHS from **7AM on 16-07-2020 to 7 P.M. on 17-07-2020.**

For eligibility criteria and regulations refer to notifications dated: 17-04-2020 and 19-04-2020.

UNIVERSITY FEE: Allotted Candidates have to pay University fee of Rs.20,600/- by way of payment gate-way on-line and download the allotment letter. Candidates who have paid university fee in previous phases need not pay again

TUITION FEE: Tuition fee is to be paid at respective Dental colleges. The tuition fee payable as per Government of Telangana orders and interim orders of Hon'ble High Court of Telangana in WP.No.6799 of 2020 .

The details of seats available (seat matrix) are placed in the website <http://knruhs.telangana.gov.in> The candidates can exercise web options for PG MDS Courses in all Dental Colleges under KNRUHS through <https://tsmds.tsche.in>

The allotment of seats will be made in accordance with the existing Government orders.

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES:

- I. Candidates can exercise web-options for seats in PG Dental Courses in all Dental Colleges through <https://tsmds.tsche.in>
- II. Eligible PG Dental candidates as per provisional final merit list can exercise web options for Post Graduate MDS seats in All Dental Colleges for Dental Courses in order of their interest and priority.
- III. Service Candidates whose names are displayed in the provisional final merit list for PG Dental Admissions on KNURHS web-site can exercise web options for PG MDS seats reserved for Service Candidates as per eligibility.
- IV. Eligible candidates under Persons with Disability (PWD) category whose names are displayed as eligible candidates in KNRUHS web site can exercise web options for PG MDS seats reserved under PWD quota.
- V. Candidates are advised to go through the prospectus of KNRUHS available on website before exercising web options for the regulations.
- VI. Candidates exercising web options for PG MDS courses are informed that, there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web-options, candidates can exercise web options for any number of subjects and colleges the candidate is interested to join as per eligibility.

- VII. Candidates are advised to exercise web options for PG MDS seats in all courses and colleges in which they are interested to join irrespective of vacancies in seat matrix displayed as sliding vacancies will arise during counseling process due to sliding of candidates allotted seats in previous phase to other seats as per their options in the final round. If they are not interested to change the course or college they need not exercise web options for the same.
- VIII. **IMPORANT NOTE : CANDIDATES ARE INFORMED THAT IF THEY EXERCISE WEB- OPTIONS FOR A SEAT AND ALLOTTED A SEAT AS PER THEIR CHOICE IN THIS PHASE OF COUNSELING AND IF THEY DO NOT JOIN THE COURSE AT THE ALLOTTED COLLEGE, THEN THEY WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR EXERCISING WEB-OPTIONS FOR MOP UP PHASE OF COUNSELING TO PREVENT SEAT BLOCKING.**
- IX. Candidates are advised to opt for seats and courses in which they are interested to join, if they are not interested to join they should not give options and provide opportunity for next meritorious candidates and prevent blockade / wastage of seats.
- X. **CANDIDATES ARE INFORMED THAT IF THEY ARE ALLOTTED A SEAT AS PER THEIR OPTIONS IN THIS PHASE OF COUNSELING, THE SEAT IN WHICH THEY HAVE JOINED IN THE PREVIOUS PHASE IS AUTOMATICALLY CANCELLED AND RE-ALLOTTED TO OTHER CANDIDATES.**
- XI. Candidates can exercise options on the web either from home / any other place through a computer having internet facility.
- XII. One Time Password (OTP) will be sent to the registered mobile at the time of saving web options. The password consists of SIX letter code with English capitals A to Z (for details read instructions to the candidates before giving options).
- XIII. The selected candidates shall download the allotment letter from website after payment of the University fee by gateway method by using Online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking), check their allotment and report to the Principal of respective college and join the course on or before the date specified on the allotment letter.
- XIV. Candidates are hereby informed that verification of original certificates will be conducted at the college of admission and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action may be initiated as per University Regulations.
- XV. Selected candidates have to join the course at the respective colleges before the last date for joining as specified on the allotment letter with all original certificates, submit the relevant bonds and pay the tuition fee / college fee to complete the process of admission and join for duties.

- XVI.** If the candidate does not fulfill the above criteria to complete the admission process within the specified date, the admission will be cancelled automatically and the candidate will not be permitted to exercise web options for mop up phase of counseling to prevent seat blocking.
- XVII.** If the candidate slides to other college during mop up phase of counseling, the original certificates will be sent to the college concerned after the closure of admissions.
- XVIII.** Candidates who does not join the course after allotment in final phase of counseling or discontinues the course after joining will not be eligible to exercise web options for Mop up round.
- XIX.** *Candidates cannot withdraw from the course after joining in the final phase of counseling after last date for free exit to be notified by University on Website before notification for mop up phase of counseling.* Candidates can withdraw from the course before the last date of free exit as notified by University before mop up phase of counseling notification without paying any penalty. Those candidates will not be eligible for exercising options for Mop-up round.
- XX.** Candidates will have to pay discontinuation fee of Rs. 5 lakhs and will also be debarred for 3 years from participating in the PG admission process of KNRUHS, if they discontinue the course after the last date of free exit as per notification is issued before mop up round of counseling. If they discontinue later and before closure of admission it will be considered as being involved in seat blocking and the original certificates also will be returned after closure of admissions after payment of penalty amount.
- XXI.** The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
