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ORDER:

In pursuance of the judgment of the Government of India orders vide reference 12th cited and also discussions held with the Private Unaided Minority Medical Colleges in the State for the Under Graduate Courses i.e., MBBS and BDS, a consensual arrangement has been arrived in adopting the admission policy and seat matrix for the competent authority seats, Management seats and NRI seats in Unaided Minority Medical / Dental Colleges in the State from NEET qualified candidates.

2. The Government after careful examination have decided to amend the Telangana State Un-aided Minority Professional Institutions (Regulations of Admissions into Under Graduate Medical and Dental Professional Courses) Rules 2007 issued in G.O.Ms.No.272, HM&FW(E1) Department, Dated: 10th July 2006 and as amended subsequently vide G.O.Ms.No. 130 HM&FW(C1) Department Dated: 12-09-2016.

3. Accordingly, the following notification shall be published in the Extraordinary issue of the Telangana Gazette dated. 07/07/2017.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 3 and 15 of the Telangana State Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983 (A.P. Act No. 5 of 1983) and in supersession of the Telangana Un-aided Minority Professional Institutions (Regulations of Admissions into Under Graduate Medical and Dental Professional Courses) Rules, 2006 issued in G.O.Ms No. 272, HM & FW(E1) Department Dated: 10/07/2006 and published in the extraordinary issue of A.P. Gazette dated:12/07/2006.

In the said rules:

## A M E N D M E N T S

I. For Rule 1 ( G.O.Ms.No. 130) 'Allotment of seats', the following shall be substituted:

The seats to be allotted in each unaided Minority Professional Institutions under these rules, for admission of candidates shall be as:

Category –A seats (50% of the sanctioned intake of the seats)

Competent authority seats:- These seats shall be filled in through the counseling by the committee constituted by the competent authority i.e. Vice Chancellor, KNRUHS, Warangal as per merit from the minority candidates who are qualified at NEET held by the Government of India for that year. All seats will be filled with the respective Minority candidates allowing horizontal reservations as per existing rules. But the Horizontal reservations will be applicable to the respective Minority candidates only.

Category – B seats (35% of the sanctioned intake of the seats)

NEET qualified ranking based management seats:- The seats shall be filled through the counseling by the committee for admission constituted by competent authority (Vice Chancellor of KNRUHS) as per the merit from the candidates who are qualified in NEET for that year. The committee constituted will include one nominee of Minority Medical Colleges and Director of Medical Education, T.S.Hyd. The Registrar KNR UHS will be Convener KNR UHS Officers will assist the selection committee. The notification will be issued by the KNR UHS and admission process will be completed as per schedule by the selection committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor.

Category – C seats (15% NRI quota)

These seats shall be filled by the competent authority i.e. Vice Chancellor of KNR UHS through selection committee constituted for category B-seats and notification will be issued by the KNR UHS from NEET qualified NRI candidates. Eligibility criteria for NRI candidates admissions will be as per MCI Regulations issued from time to time.

II. For Rule 5 ( II of G.O.Ms.No. 130) 'Authority for Admissions', the following shall be substituted:

- i) Category –A seats (50% of the sanctioned intake of the seats) shall be filled by the committee for admissions constituted by the competent authority under these rules.
- ii) Category – B Seats (35% of the sanctioned intake of the seats) shall be filled by the committee for admissions constituted by competent authority i.e. Vice Chancellor of KNRUHS, which includes one member from Minority Medical Colleges, Director of Medical Education, T.S. and Registrar, KNR UHS will be the Convener. The KNR UHS Officials will assist the committee.
- iii) Category – C seats (15% NRI quota) These seats shall be filled by the committee for admissions constituted by competent authority i.e. Vice Chancellor of KNRUHS, which includes one member from, one member from Minority Medical Colleges, Director of Medical Education Director of Medical Education, T.S. and Registrar, KNR UHS will be the Convener. The KNR UHS Officials will assist the committee.

III. For Rule 6 (B), ( III of G.O.Ms.No. 130) the following shall be substituted:

6. (B) to fill up NEET qualified ranking based management seats:

(Category B -35% of the sanctioned intake of seats)

- i. B Seats (35% of the sanctioned intake of the seats) shall be filled by the committee for admissions constituted by competent authority i.e. Vice Chancellor of KNRUHS, which includes one member from Minority Medical Colleges, Director of Medical Education Director of Medical Education, T.S. and Registrar, KNR UHS will be the Convener. The KNR UHS Officials will assist the committee.

- ii. The KNR UHS will also issue the guidelines for selection and allotment of candidates against the above seats basing upon the rules of Government of India / Government of Telangana as applicable.
- iii. The Convener shall issue notification in at least two leading news papers calling for a single common application for admissions into the above seats (B & C categories) in all the private medical and dental colleges from applicants all over India. Further details of schedule of counseling will be notified on University Website.
- iv. Category B seats shall be filled by the committee for admissions constituted by competent authority i.e. Vice Chancellor of KNRUHS, which includes one member from one member from Minority Medical Colleges, Director of Medical Education, Director of Medical Education, T.S. and Registrar, KNR UHS will be the Convener. The KNR UHS Officials will assist the committee.
- v. The convener for Council of admissions for Management quota shall complete the process of admission within the time frame notified by the Government of India and following such procedure as prescribed for making admissions into the category B seats of all Private Medical & Dental Colleges by Government of India / Government of Telangana.
- vi. The convener shall fix a date, time and venue for conducting the counselling
- vii. The candidates who are qualified to seek admission as a consequence of obtaining rank in NEET test and desirous of seeking admission into the Private Unaided Non Minority Professional Institutions shall be called for the counseling after applying online in response to notification issued by University.
- viii. The admission shall be made in the following manner:
  - a. The committee shall prepare the merit list based on the online applications from NEET qualified candidates and display on the web-site of KNR UHS after verification of certificates.
  - b. The candidate shall attend the counseling with all original certificates. The competent authority shall select the candidate in the counseling by calling for candidates based on NEET ranking and as per the seat matrix approved.
  - c. The candidates selected for admission into unaided private minority professional colleges shall pay the prescribed fee in the form of demand draft drawn on any national bank in favour of "Principal of the College". If a candidate fails to pay the fee on the day of reporting, the selection will be cancelled forthwith and will be filled with subsequent selection by counseling as per the prescribed procedure.
  - d. Once a candidate secures admission to a particular college / course based on his/her option, no more claims to admission into other colleges /course be entertained during that academic year.
  - e. If a candidate after final selection fails to report to the principal of respective colleges on or before the stipulated time, he/she shall deemed to have forfeited the seat and all such category B unfilled seats shall be treated as vacant and the vacant seats shall be filled by the convener before the closure of admissions.
  - f. All unfilled seats under Category A after final counseling will be surrendered to the convener, selection committee constituted by the competent authority who is Vice Chancellor, KNR UHS, Warangal. Such un-filled seats will be treated as category - B seats and filled by the convener by merit. If any seats falls vacant, all such seats will be converted to C-Category seats and will be filled by the convener following merit from the merit list notified. All the process to be completed before the closure of the admissions. No seat will be filled after the closure of the admissions in any form.
  - g. The above rules shall be followed scrupulously. Any violation of the rules shall entail cancellation of admissions of the candidates concerned and the conduct of admissions afresh following the procedure etc.

- ix. All the private Minority Medical and Dental Colleges shall adhere to the above procedures scrupulously. Any deviation / malpractices thereof will entail severe disciplinary action by the competent authority.

IV. Category – C (NRI Quota seats) (15% of the total intake of the seats): These seats shall be filled by the convener, selection committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor following due procedure. All seats shall be filled from the merit list prepared on NEET Ranks.

- i. The candidates shall submit an affidavit to establish the bonafides that they are NRI /children /wards of bonafide NRI residents.
- ii. The admissions made under the NRI quota should be according to the NEET qualified merit list of that year prepared by the Convener from the applicants.
- iii. Eligibility criteria for NRI candidates admissions will be as per MCI Regulations issued from time to time.

V. In case minority candidates are not available for management quota seats, the seats can be filled up by non-minority candidates in the last round of counseling. The non-minority candidates should not exceed 30% of total seats.

All the candidates joining the MBBS/BDS course (Competent Authority Quota, Management Quota, All India Quota) should execute a bond on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- value as prescribed signed by candidate and parents to ensure completion of prescribed period of training or in default or discontinuation for any other reason has to pay an amount of Rs. 20,00,000-00 (Rupees Twenty lakhs only) to KNR University of Health Sciences."

- (ii) In sub clause (f), after the words "admission in any form.", the following words shall be added, namely:-

"After the last phase of counseling by the University, leftover seats shall be permitted to be filled by the Management of the respective colleges from the relevant merit list in accordance with the vacancies. The University shall notify a merit list of eligible candidates on the University website at 1:10 ratio in proportion to the total number of vacant seats available in all medical colleges in obedience to the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court in W.P.(C) No.267/2017 and others. (ex:- If 50 vacant seats are available, the selection has to be made from merit list of 50X10=500 candidates notified by University)"

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**ORDER:**

In the G.O. 1<sup>st</sup> read above, orders were issued for fixation of the fee structure and certain directions in respect of under graduate (BDS) and post graduate (MDS) in Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad.

2. Orders were issued in G.O 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> read above for fixation of the fee structure in respect of Under Graduate Medical / Dental courses in Private Unaided Non-minority & Minority Colleges respectively in the state for the academic year 2016-2017.

3. In the G.O. 4<sup>th</sup> read above, orders were issued for retaining the existing fee structure for the Under Graduate Medical / Dental courses in private Unaided Minority Colleges, duly retaining the terms & conditions laid in G.O.3<sup>rd</sup> read above.

4. In the G.O. 5<sup>th</sup> read above, orders were issued for Undergraduate Medical / Dental Courses, increasing 5 % tuition fee for category B seats and in respect of C category, the fee shall not exceed two (2) times of "B" category seats for Private Unaided Non-Minority Colleges for academic year 2017-2018.

5. In the reference 6<sup>th</sup> read above, Telangana Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee, Hyderabad submitted its recommendations for fixation of fee structure for M.B.B.S, B.D.S courses for the block period 2020-2023 and requested the Government to issue necessary orders.

6. In the G.O.7<sup>th</sup> read above, orders were issued to retain the existing fee structure for the Undergraduate Medical and Dental Courses in Army College of Dental Sciences and in Private Unaided Non-Minority / Minority Medical and Dental Colleges, for the year 2020-2021 in view of the special circumstances due to COVID-19 pandemic, duly retaining the terms and conditions laid in G.O. 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> read above.

7. Government after examination of the matter, hereby accept the recommendations of the Telangana Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee and fix the fee structure for undergraduate medical (M.B.B.S) and dental courses (B.D.S) for the remaining block period 2021-2023 as appended to this order as annexure-I & II for the private unaided non-minority/minority medical and dental colleges in the state and also the Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad.

8. The following conditions shall be followed by all the private unaided non-minority / minority medical and dental colleges in the state:-

- (i) The Management shall not charge any capitation fee and there shall not be any profiteering. Except the above fee fixed by the Committee, no other amount, either directly or indirectly, can be charged un-authorizedly or

illegally by the management. If any such other amount is charged under any other head or guise (e.g. Donation etc.) it would amount to charging of capitation fee. The surplus (profit) that is generated from the collection of the fee must be for the benefit of the institution and cannot be diverted for other purposes or for personal gain.

- (ii) The total fee of the course (4 ½ years) shall be collected at the beginning of every academic year and in five installments.
- (iii) The same fee shall continue for the students admitted during the block period of 2021-23 till they complete the course.
- (iv) The managements of the institutions may seek bank guarantee for tuition fee chargeable for every succeeding year.

9. The Registrar, KNR University of Health Sciences, Warangal, the Principals of all the private unaided non-minority / minority medical and dental colleges in the state and also Principal of Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.
