- Sub:- KNRUHS Exams Conduct of Second MBBS (New Regulations) Supplementary Examinations in the month of July 2024 – Issue of Notification – Regarding.

This notification is issued for registration of the candidates to appear for Second MBBS (New Regulations) Supplementary Examinations commencing from **16.07.2024**.

1) <u>Eligibility to appear for Second MBBS (New Regulations) Supplementary</u> <u>Examinations:</u>

The MBBS students admitted by the KNRUHS during the academic year 2021-22 whose admissions are approved by the University and also students of previous batches who have failed, detained and not registered for the said examinations conducted earlier are eligible to appear for the examinations in July 2024 subject to the course regulations.

- 2) The Second MBBS students who are having minimum 75% ATTENDANCE IN THEORY AND 80% ATTENDANCE IN PRACTICAL/CLINICAL in each subject and scored minimum 50% (FIFTY PERCENT) marks in internal assessment examinations are eligible to appear for the examinations.
- 3) The Cut-off date for calculation of attendance percentage of the students is up to <u>05.06.2024</u>.
- The uploading of the attendance percentage and internal assessment marks of the students is from <u>11.06.2024</u> to <u>13.06.2024</u>.
- 5) The confirmation date for uploaded attendance and internal assessment marks is on <u>15.06.2024</u>.

Digital valuation and providing only single answer booklet without additional answer booklet:

The University is a digital campus and implementing digital valuation for all courses. For MBBS course, single answer booklet with candidate specific bar code on each page will be issued to the candidates appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer booklet only.
